- 1. You are fearfully and wonderfully made. (Psalm 139:13-14)

- 3. As His child, God will graciously give you all things. (Ephesians 3:20)
- 4. Nothing can separate you from the love of God. (John 10:28-30, Romans 8:38-39)
- 5. God is fully in control of ALL things. (Col 1:16-17, Job 42:2)
