Sermon Summary

Peacemakers feel like the Gospel. Relationships matter. We carry the Good News of Jesus across all the boundaries and barriers that normally divide us. We cross boundaries of geography, culture, race, class and ideology. The eighth piece of being a peacemaker is bringing the Gospel of Peace to everyone. This week we learn how to be people of influence who open doors for the Gospel.

Discussion Questions

How was your Memorial Day Weekend?

How do you typically do with meeting new people?

What about when you meet and interact with somebody from a completely different context as you (age, race, religion, country of origin, etc.)?

Read Romans 10:9-15

When did you first “declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead”?

Who helped lead you to this decision?

How long was it between the time that you first *heard* the Gospel to the time that you *believed* it in your own heart?

Have you ever considered your feet to be beautiful? HA! Well, if they are fitted with the readiness that comes from the Gospel of Peace (Eph. 6:15), then they are!



What would it take for you to view yourself as more of a “foot soldier” carrying the Good News – the Gospel -- to the lost?

What are some of the first steps in this, especially for folks who are different than you?

Matt gave us three statements to consider:

1. People of Peace are people of blessing.
2. People of peace are people of the Kingdom.
3. People of peace are people of the Message of Peace

How are you doing in these areas? How can you get better?

Are you willing to take responsibility to be people of peace?

Are you willing to pay the price of being people of peace?
