October 7

God Promises Sarah a Son Genesis 18:1-15; 21:1-6 God brings us laughter

Sarah hears God promise she'll have a son within the next year. Sarah is very old, so she laughs at the idea. But by the next year, she has a son. She names him Isaac, which means laughter, because God brought her laughter. God brings us laughter, too.

Through the Week

God brings us laughter, so have some fun with your family.

- Get a roll of transparent tape.
- Have each person stick long pieces to his or her face so it pulls the skin in different directions. (You can get ideas by doing an Internet search for "Scotch tape faces.")
- When you look at each other, you're sure to laugh.
- Look in the mirror, too, and laugh at yourself.
- Share funny things that have happened to you recently, and thank God for laughter.

October 14

God Brings Jacob and Esau Back Together Genesis 27; 21-33

God helps us make things right

Jacob tricks his dad into giving him his brother's blessing. Jacob's brother Esau is mad, so Jacob runs away. After years apart, Jacob sends gifts to Esau to try to make up. Esau forgives Jacob, and the brothers reunite.

Through the Week

- Read Ephesians 4:26 as a family.
- Before bed each night this week, encourage your family to reflect on any conflicts they've had that day with other family members.
- Make it a point to hold hands and pray together before bed.
- Pay attention to how God helps you make things right in your family as you include him in your conflict resolution.

October 21

God Has a Plan for Joseph *Genesis 37–50*

God has a big picture through ups and downs
Joseph has a lot of ups and downs. His brothers sell him into
slavery. He becomes a respected servant but then goes to jail.
Finally, the Pharaoh asks Joseph to interpret his dream and then

gives him an important role. God has a big picture through ups and downs.

Through the Week

- Find something you can use as a dry-erase surface, such as a window or mirror.
- Set out washable or dry-erase markers.
- Draw the axes of a graph, with the left axis numbered 1-10 and the bottom axis showing the days of the week.
- Assign each family member a color of marker.
- Each day, everyone will add a dot to show what number best reflects that day. If it was an amazing day, that's a 10. If it was a horrible day, that's a 1.
- Pray for each other daily based on the graph.

October 28 God Sends Miriam to Protect Moses Exodus 2:1-10

God takes care of us though others

Pharaoh makes a rule to kill all Hebrew baby boys. When Moses is born, his mother manages to hide him. Then God uses Moses' sister, Miriam, to keep Moses safe as he floats in a basket in the Nile River. God takes care of us through others, so Moses stays safe

Through the Week

- Assign each person one day of the week. On each day, that person will be "Moses."
- Everyone else in the family will think of ways to take care of Moses. For example, you might fold that person's laundry, make Moses a special treat, or make his or her bed.
- Moses shouldn't be demanding or ask for help; everyone should just be looking for ways to care more for Moses.
- At the end of the week, talk about how it felt to be cared for.
 Also talk about what it was like finding ways to care for others.

November 4

God Rescues the Israelites Exodus 12:1-42;14:5-31 God wants what is best for us

God sends a final plague so Pharaoh will let the Israelites escape. God kills all the firstborn sons, passing over homes with lambs' blood on the door frames. The Israelites escape, but the Red Sea is in their way. God parts the Red Sea. God wants what's best for us.

Through the Week

- Look up the following verses with your family. Write them on sticky notes or index cards.
 - Romans 8:28 Proverbs 3:5-6 Jeremiah 29:11 Philippians 4:6 Psalm 46:1 Joshua 1:9
- You could also find other verses that remind you to trust God's plan.
- If your child made the "Reminder Sheep" craft, you can add the cards from that craft as well.
- Hang the notes around a door frame you'll all walk through often your front door or a bathroom door, for example.
- Whenever you walk through that door, remember how God did what was best for the Israelites when he kept them safe and how God wants what's best for you.
